TBS Marine Fishing Classic

Friday 8th, Saturday 9th & Sunday 10th June 2018

Rules

1. All competitors must hold a current Victorian fishing license and abide by the Victorian fishing and boating regulations.
 2. Open competitors must pay a \$70 registration fee (Pre-Registration \$65) & junior competitors must pay \$25 before fishing. (Juniors must be 5-16years old) Registration points are at the Dartmouth Hall from 9 am till 9 pm Friday. 9am till 12noon Saturday. Junior Competitors can enter the Open Competition but must pay the Open entry price to be eligible to win the boat, motor & trailer. Junior Competitors cannot enter in both competitions.
 3. If you are fishing for THE CLUB or TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP you must enter your club or team's name on the registration slip before fishing. Registration fee \$10 per person in each club or team. You must be entered as a competitor to enter as a Club or Team. **Each person can only enter in a Team or a Club not both**
*** Teams are Limited to 8 competitors * Club are limited to 15 competitors**
 4. Fishing commences at 5am on Friday Morning and finishes at 4pm on Sunday
 5. All competitors will receive a number on a registration Card which MUST be presented at the Weigh ins & presentation night.
 6. Weigh in will commence between **4.30pm and 7.00pm** on Friday & Saturday at the Dartmouth Pub complex and **2.00pm and 4.00pm SHARP** Sunday at the Dartmouth Pub complex. **Live Weigh in will commence between 2.00 pm and 4.00 pm at the Boat Ramp on Friday & Saturday Only (Live & Dead Trout Only).**
 7. Carp can be weighed in at any time at the food tent at the boat ramp as well as the weigh in station during weigh in Times.
 8. Presentation will be at 8.00pm on Sunday at the Dartmouth Pub.
 9. The area to be fished is Lake Dartmouth Dam, Mitta Mitta River to the Mitta Mitta Bridge on Dartmouth Road.
 10. **MINIMUM SIZE FOR SIZE FOR WEIGH-INS IS 35CM IN LENGTH.**
 11. Trout are to be gilled and gutted before being weighed. Carp **do not** need to be gilled and gutted (Except for Live Trout)
***If you have caught a TROPHY size trout that you would like to keep intact, you may weigh this trout in BUT 10% of its weight will be deducted.
 12. Frozen fish will not be accepted.
 13. All Trout will be clipped when weighed.
(Except for Live Trout)
 14. Only (2) trout may be weighed in on each day to compete for the Open Trout Draw.
 15. Individual entrants are only entitled to one Species Prize for the Competition.
(Excluding per entry, sponsor & boat, motor & trailer draws)
 16. The Open Trout Draw is for TROUT only. The Open Trout Draw is selected on the night. If an angler weighs a Trout in on the Friday then they are in the draw for the Boat, Motor & Trailer if the angler weighs a Trout in Saturday then they are in the draw for the Boat, Motor & Trailer and if the angler weighs a Trout in on the Sunday they are in the draw for a Third time.
 17. Competitors must consider others during the competition, any competitors proven of unbecoming behavior by the judges will be disqualified from the competition. Any Serious infringements may be reported to the appropriate authorities
 18. ALL COMPETITORS AGREE TO ACCEPT THE JUDGES DECISION
